



EXECUTIVE PROTOCOL OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION BETWEEN SAPIENZA UNIVERSITY OF ROME (ITALY) AND THE UNIVERSITY OF JORDAN (JORDAN)

The Department of Political Science of Sapienza University of Rome, and Prince Al Hussien Bin Abdullah II School of International Studies of The University of Jordan, in order to put into practice the General Agreement signed on 15/06/2006, as well as considering the development of cultural and scientific cooperation to be of mutual advantage to both Universities and desiring to reinforce such cooperation, agree on the following points:

Art. 1: Scientific and educational cooperation shall be undertaken in the field(s) of:

- a) Political sciences;
- b) International relations;
- c) Cultural processes;
- d) Social processes

Such cooperation shall be carried out on the basis of equal and mutual advantage, reserving the opportunity to define, through mutual consent, further fields of activity. Furthermore, this consent will take into consideration the budget available at that moment in time and the experience acquired by the interested scholars from both Universities.

Art. 2: In order to achieve the objectives set out in the first article, scientific and educational cooperation may be implemented in the following ways:

- a) Exchange of visits by scholars;
- b) Participation in research programmes;
- c) Organization of scientific meetings, seminars and courses on subject(s) laid down in the agreement;
- d) Exchange of scientific information and scientific papers.

Art. 3: To implement the afore-mentioned points, it is possible to promote a reciprocal exchange of scientific staff between both Universities. In accordance with applicable norms and regulations in force in both universities and their respective countries, the contracting parties undertake to cover the cost of round trips undertaken by their own scholars (visiting professors) should funds be available, otherwise scholars should seek external funding or use personal funds. Stay costs shall be covered by the host University should funds be available; otherwise scholars should seek external funding or use personal funds. . Reciprocity in the exchange of scholars, within the conditions stated above, shall be sought but not mandatory.
