**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
Skyline University College, Sharjah, UAE
AND
The University of Jordan, Amman, Jordan**

Skyline University College, hereinafter called SUC, was established in 1990 with the purpose of delivering quality educational services to the stakeholders regionally and internationally. The institution is accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education to offer Undergraduate and Graduate programs in the field of Business. Currently SUC offers BBA program with majors in Marketing, Finance, Travel & Tourism, Information System and International Business at the undergraduate level. At graduate level, SUC offers MBA program with emphasis in Finance, Marketing, Human Resource Management and Strategic Management & Leadership.

The University of Jordan, hereinafter called UJ, was established in Amman in 1962 as a public university and is the country's oldest 4-year institution of higher education. It has evolved into a comprehensive teaching, research and community-service institution with a second branch in Aqaba, 25 faculties, 2 deanships, and 16 centers. UJ has about 1,650 full-time and 1000 part-time faculty members educating 44,000 students of whom 10% are postgraduate, and about 10% are international students coming from more than 60 countries. UJ offers 90 bachelors, 114 master's and higher specialization programs in medicine and dentistry, and 35 doctoral programs, 16 higher specialization programs in medicine and one in dentistry, and 10 professional diploma programs, where students can choose from more than 3,500 different courses

The two parties, SUC and UJ have agreed to sign this Memorandum of understanding to serve the common interest of both institutions in promoting education, training, faculty exchange, student exchange, to undertake research and project work or any other opportunity as and when it arises.

1. Objectives

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to promote the cooperation between SUC and UJ by carrying out the following activities

- i. Exchange of expertise and knowhow of the best practices followed at each institution that provides a conducive environment for learning.
- ii. Exchange of faculty
- iii. Exchange of students subject to terms to be detailed in a separate Student Exchange Agreement.
- iv. Exchange of information and best practices in the areas of
 - o Curriculum development
 - o Research

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
