



Memorandum of Understanding on Academic Cooperation

between

The University of Jordan

and

Ca' Foscari University of Venice

First party: The University of Jordan, Amman, Jordan, P.O box (11942), represented by its President or designated officer.

Second party: Ca' Foscari University of Venice, Italy, Dorsoduro 3246, represented by its Rector.

Whereas the two parties desire to develop academic cooperation in various fields, the two parties conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and agree to the following:

Article 1- To develop the following collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest:

- 1. Exchange of faculty and researchers for purposes of teaching, conducting lectures, conducting research, and exchange of expertise.
- 2. Exchange of students subject to article 5.
- 3. Conducting collaborative research projects.
- 4. Jointly organize symposia, seminars, and conferences.
- 5. Exchange of academic information and materials.

Article 2- The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties, departments or institutes, which carry out the specific projects, by means of supplementary

With the lavid and reparations of community.

Article 3- It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in article 1 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at both parties.

Article 4- Should any collaborative research activities under this MoU result in any potential for intellectual property, both parties shall seek a fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.

Article 5- The exchange students shall pay normal tuition and fees to their home institution, in accordance with that institution's policies. Neither institute shall assess charges upon the other or upon its students for tuition or fees. The exchange students shall provide for their own room and board, books, transportation, student health insurance fees and medical care, passports, visas and personal expenses.

The exchange of students shall be regulated by a specific supplementary agreement, as stated in article 2. This agreement shall detail the number of students to be exchanged yearly, their level of study, the courses offered by the parties, the provisions regarding academic tutoring and administrative management of the exchange, and all other relevant matters.

Article 6- This MoU may be amended or modified by written agreements signed by the representatives of both parties, and will become part of this MoU.

Article 7- This MoU is valid for a period of four years commencing on the date signed by the last party, and may be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both parties.

Article 8- This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the parties upon written notice to the other party not later than six months before the termination date. The termination will not affect ongoing activities.
