

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION**

BETWEEN

MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY

AND

THE UNIVERSITY OF JORDAN

Macquarie University and The University of Jordan seek to enhance relations between the two universities by developing academic co-operation and exchange of information in respect of Quality Assurance and Teaching and Learning to build capacity for academic leadership.

Within each of the university's framework of regulations, and subject to the availability of resources, the following programs and activities will be encouraged:

- Exchange of staff
- Exchange of academic materials and information
- Joint research activities
- Joint conference and other academic meetings
- Joint degrees for undergraduate and postgraduate studies

Prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity, the universities shall consult and agree in writing regarding the specific areas and details of cooperation within the framework of this agreement. The appropriate authority of each university is as follows:

Macquarie University: David Wright, Vice President, Strategy and Implementation

The University of Jordan: Rida Shibli, Vice President for Scientific Faculties and Institutes

Unless otherwise agreed in writing all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs will be determined at the discretion and be the responsibility of the visitor's home university.

All visits of staff will be subject to compliance with entry and visa requirements of the two countries involved, and the requirements of the two universities.

The memorandum becomes effective from the date of the last signature and remains in force for a period of three (3) years. Either University may terminate this memorandum by giving six months written notice to the other party. It may be extended by mutual consent of the two universities, or amended by the exchange of letter.
