



## AGREEMENT ON STUDENT EXCHANGE

between

The University of Jordan, Jordan

and

Philipps-Universität Marburg

This Agreement is entered into by and between The University of Jordan (UJ), a state-supported institution of higher education located in Amman, Jordan, and the Philipps-Universität Marburg (UMR).

### 1 Definitions

The following definitions will be used in this Agreement:

- **Contracting parties:** The University of Jordan and Philipps-Universität Marburg.
- **Home Institution:** The contracting partner that has agreed to send the exchange student.
- **Host Institution:** The contracting partner that has agreed to receive the exchange student.
- **Exchange students:** The students of both institutions involved in the exchange according to this Agreement

### 2 Objectives

The purpose of the Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which the exchange of students between UJ and UMR shall take place. The terms and conditions of the Agreement apply to both undergraduate and post-graduate students. Admission of candidates to study at UJ and UMR will be at the discretion of the Host Institution.

### 3 Numbers of Students

Each year during the term of this Agreement, each Institution may send up to three (3) students for two semesters or six (6) students for one semester to be enrolled as exchange students at the other institution. The number of students may be modified from time to time by mutual agreement. It is understood that a balance in number of students exchanged shall be sought over a four year period.

The obligations of the institutions under this Agreement apply only to the exchange students, and exclude both spouses and dependents.
