

**Memorandum of Understanding
on Academic Cooperation
between
The University of Jordan
and
Technische Universität Chemnitz**

First party: The University of Jordan, Amman, 11492, Jordan, represented by its President of designated officer

Second party: Technische Universität Chemnitz, Straße der Nationen 62, 09107 Chemnitz, Germany, represented by its Vice-Rector for Research and Young Scientists, Prof. Dr. Heinrich Lang

Whereas the two parties desire to develop academic cooperation in various fields, the two parties conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and agree to the following:

Article 1 – To develop the following collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest:

1. Exchange of faculty and researchers for purposes of teaching, conducting lectures, conducting research and exchange of expertise
2. Exchange of students subject to terms to be outlined in a separate Student Exchange Agreement
3. Conducting collaborative research projects
4. Jointly organize symposia, seminars and conferences
5. Exchange of academic information and materials

Article 2 – Both universities nominate a responsible person for the cooperation:

For Technische Universität Chemnitz the responsible person will be:

For University of Jordan the responsible person will be:
Director, Office of International Relation
E-mail: oirp@ju.edu.jo

Article 3 – The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties or institutes which carry out the specific projects. Both parties agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of both countries.

Article 4 – It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in article 1 shall depend upon the availability of resources and the financial support of both parties. Both parties will apply for funds from various agencies, for instance the German Academic Exchange Service or any other institutions. The volume and the frequency of the exchange will depend on the funds available.



Article 5 – Should any collaborative research activities under this MoU result in any potential for intellectual property, both parties shall seek a fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise. Further conditions have to be negotiated for scientific projects in specific contracts.

Article 6 – This MoU may be amended or modified by written agreements signed by the representatives of both parties and will become part of this MoU.

Article 7 – This MoU is valid for a period of four years commencing on the date signed by the last party and may be renewed after being reviewed and renegotiated by both parties.

Article 8 – This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the parties upon written notice to the other party not later than six months before the termination date. The termination will not affect ongoing activities
